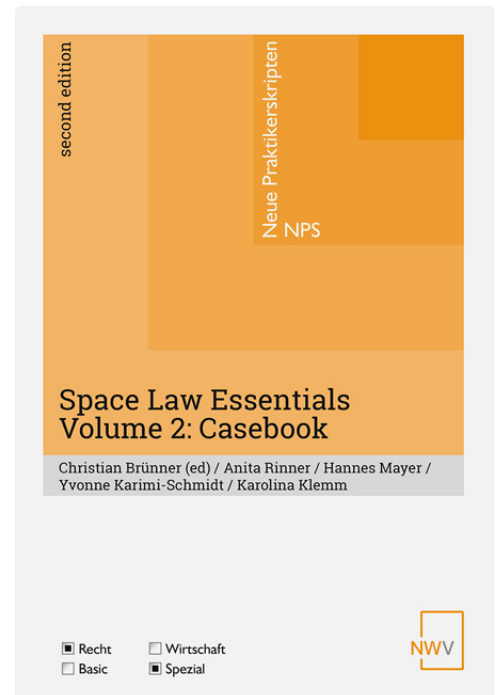


Space Law Essentials
